2.2. ENTRY TYPES



The Professional Edition is the most common way to take part in the A' Design Award and Competition, it is the original value proposition for any participant type to take part in a design accolades.

The professional edition covers the full spectrum of A' Design Prize which includes the Trophy, Yearbook, Exhibition, Certificate, Logo Licensing, Gala-Night as well as PR Services such as Press Release, Design Interviews, International Translations, Media Pitching and more.



The Digital Entry was created especially with young and start-up account types in mind.

In short, this is a digital version of the professional edition; this implies that the hardcopy deliverables in the winners' kit such as the award trophy, the hardcover yearbook, the certificate in metal frame as well as some other benefits such as invitation to join the gala-night, physical exhibition are **excluded** in order to create a possibility for us to reduce the nomination fees significantly

- Both entry methods (Pro Entry or Digital Entry) have the **same evaluation methodology** and the jury members do not differentiate nor know if they are voting a digital edition entry or professional edition entry. This ensures that both entry methods have the same scientific peer-review and anonymous voting evaluation criteria, while decreasing the cost of participation by reducing the deliverable items after the competition.

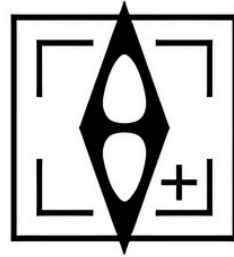

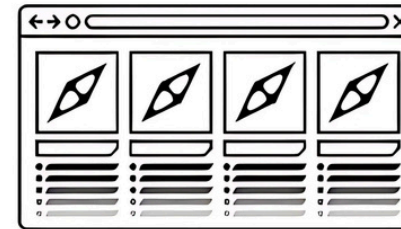

You can upload your new designs via the "Upload a New Design" tab. You can manage, edit, and update all your existing designs or nominate a design for an award through the "My Designs" section.

Not all submissions are the same, and in many cases, it is possible to see participants entering the competition with a submission that is quickly eliminated due to presentation issues. To address this problem and improve the overall quality of submissions, A' Design Award previously released the [Submission Guidelines](#); this is a detailed, image-rich document that can be downloaded for free, guiding you through the submission process and offering tips and suggestions for making a strong submission.

3.3. FREE PRELIMINARY EVALUATION



When you upload your design to the A' Design Awards, it will undergo a preliminary review by a randomly assigned jury member after some time. This consultancy service is free, and you will receive constructive feedback on how to improve your presentation.

The following aspects are considered: fundamental design quality, visualization and presentation features, category compatibility, visuals, descriptive text, video, and documents. Your design will either be approved (for nomination) or rejected (with suggestions for improving the presentation to make it more competitive before or after nomination). You will receive an update via email suggesting the next course of action.

Submission Quality Score

Each submission will be assigned a Submission Quality Score, which will be evaluated by a submission optimization expert. This score is not the same as the **design score** assigned during the preliminary review (please do not confuse these two concepts). The Submission Quality Score is more related to the presentation of your submission and your overall score.

Given the restricted text area, inspirations, unique properties or technical information could be mentioned; this information will be included also in press-releases and will also be used in the IDIN network to disseminate your work. Prepare this section by thinking like an editor; how would you mention this work in your publication if you were to feature it. This section is not required during submission, but is required after results are announced. - Please fill-in all optional text fields for this entry and try to expand existing textual descriptions by providing more details. For the operation / flow / interaction field please explain how the end user interacts with the Transporting Vegetables. For the tags section, please remember to type in related keywords related to the Transporting Vegetables separated by comma. Please fill the production / realization technology section by explaining how the Transporting Vegetables design is realized; i.e. briefly explain processes, methods, techniques or materials. Please enter specifications of the Transporting Vegetables to the specifications / dimensions / package / technical properties section; in this section you could discuss technical details, procedures etc. Please enter research conducted and research findings utilized during the design of the Transporting Vegetables to the research abstract field. Please explain any difficulties overcome or any issues arise and surpassed during the design of the Transporting Vegetables to the challenge text field; here explain particularly what was the most difficult issue when designing the Transporting Vegetables and how you have mastered the issue. The jury member also rated your design's likelihood of winning the A' Design Award from a scale of 0 (min) to 10 (max) based on the insights gathered in previous years, and gave your design a score of 5 out of 10. A Likert score of 5 means that: if nominated, your design is less likely to win a A' Design Award and more likely to become a Runner-Up. Your design is very less likely to receive participant status. Please note that this is the personal opinion of the preliminary jury member and is not 100% accurate, however our research over a data set of 2500 previous entries show that, 90% of the time, the insights of the preliminary jury members are very close to the final result. Please remember that you can improve your score by improving the overall presentation quality by following the notes by the jury member.

05. EVALUATION CRITERIA

For each design competition category, the relevant "design" details are addressed and are voted by three different juries, the juries have equal weight at this point, the questions are answered on a scale from zero to eleven.

Design;

refers to aesthetics of form and shape, texture, finishing, graphical communication, colors and color options, material, innovation, emotional values, social context, targeted segment relevance, engineering, ease of use, surprise element, timelessness of design.

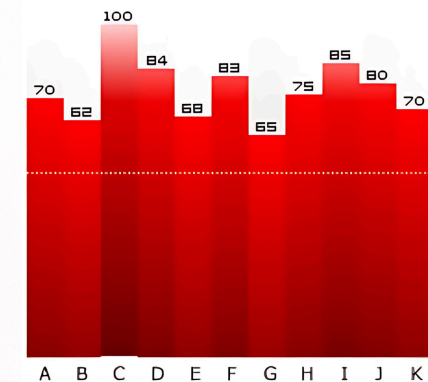
Engineering;

refers in general to the function, ergonomics, usability, details, technical engineering, ease of production, efficiency of production, economies of scale, marketability, technological availability, safety, cost advantage, resource friendliness, sustainability, reparability, durability, impact on nature, recyclability, reusability, responsiveness and similar details.

Design Presentation;

the visualization of use and maintenance, clearness representation and relevant details are addressed

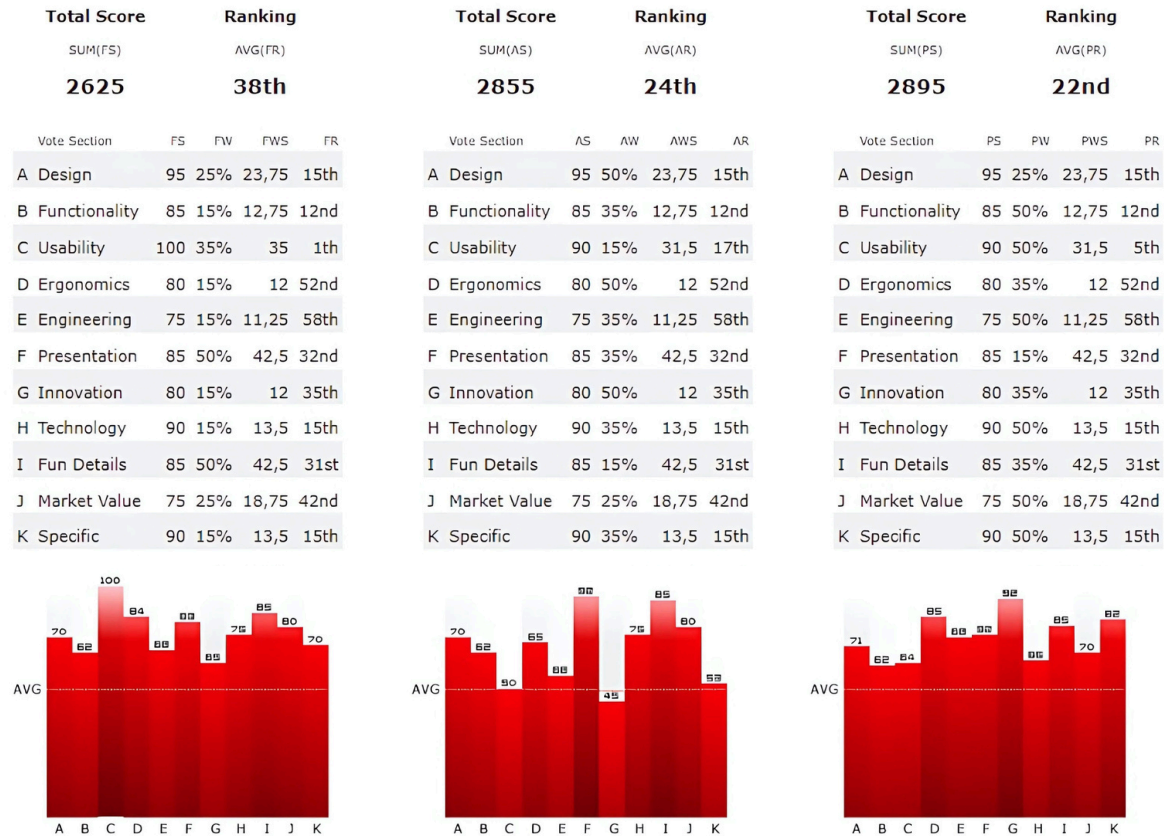

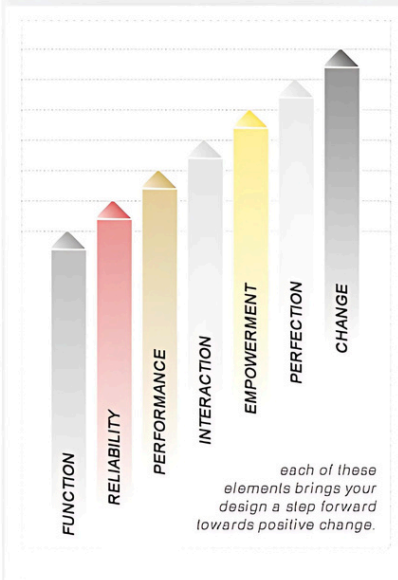

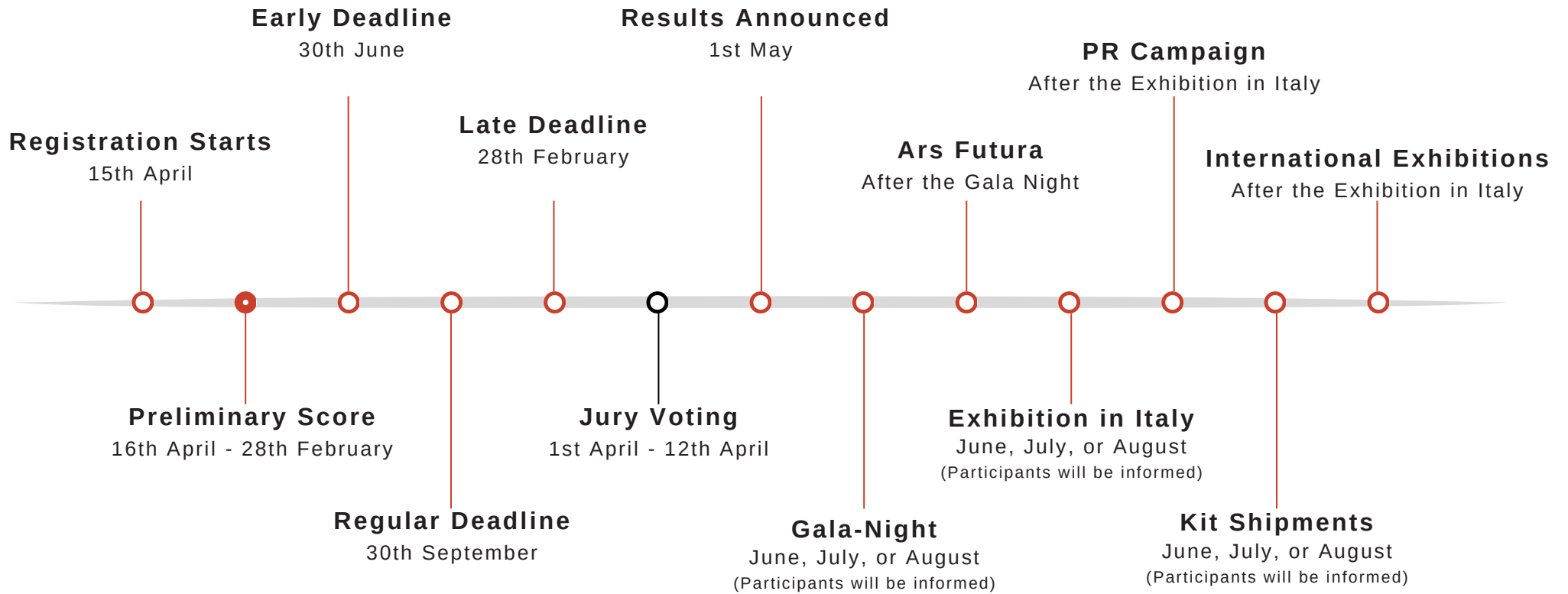
The Gala-Night is a very special black-tie event where the winners of the competition come together to celebrate the results of the competition. The event aims to create networking opportunities and media coverage for winners.
